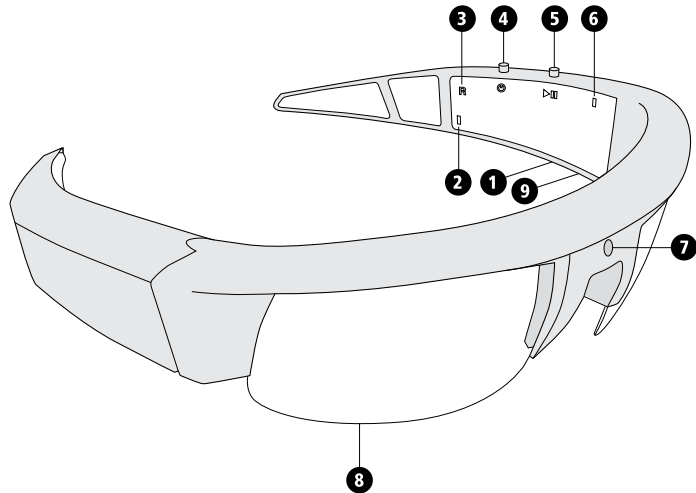

SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

- 1. CPU must be at least 1.6Ghz or above.
- 2. Operating system: Win 98/Me/2000/XP/Vista.
- 3. USB port.
- 4. Minimum 1GB free hard disk space.
- 5. Minimum 512MB memory.
- Mac OSX 10.3.6 or higher.

GETTING STARTED

CHARGING THE BATTERY

Plug the small end of the USB cable into connector ① and the large end into either the UK mains charger or your computer, and we've also included a car charger for when you're on the move.

For the initial 3 charges, the battery needs to be charged for at least 8-12 hours to ensure its future performance. Do not charge it more than 12 hours.

The Power LED ② will glow Red when charging and will change to Green when battery is fully charged.

You must only use the mains and car chargers that we have provided to avoid damage to the product.

If you haven't used the device for a long period of time, we suggest you recharge the battery first before using it.

Charge the battery in power-off mode for a faster recharge and better product protection.

OPERATION

SWITCH ON

Press the On/Off button ④ for 1 second, the LED's ② and ⑥ will glow green and blue for 7-8 seconds while initialisation procedures occur. When the blue LED ⑥ goes off and only the Green LED ② stays on, the device is in standby status.

SWITCH OFF

In standby status press and hold the On/Off button ④ for 2-3 seconds, this will switch the device off.

AUTO SHUT-OFF

If you leave the device in standby status without operation for 30 seconds it will automatically shut

off for power saving. You will need to switch it on again if you want to record.

START RECORDING

In standby status, press and hold the Recording button ⑤ for 2-3 seconds, the LED ⑥ will start flashing Blue to show it's now recording both video and audio.

CAUTION: Recording directly towards the sun for a long period may damage the camera.

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OPERATION

STOP RECORDING

Press and hold the Recording button **5** for 2-3 seconds, the LED **6** will stop flashing and glow solid blue until the data has been saved to the memory.

When all the data has been saved, the LED **6** will go off, leaving the LED **2** to glow green and you're back in standby status and ready for the next recording. If the blue light stays on it means the memory is full and you will need to download/delete files to create space.

CONNECTING TO PC OR LAPTOP

1. Plug the USB cable into Connector **1** and then to your PC or Laptop through USB port.
2. The computer will recognise the newly added hardware and will install the driver if required.
3. After automatic installation a new window will appear with the video files you have just recorded ready for downloading.
4. You can then copy and save to your hard drive.

	PC Bios disabled	Set USB enabled in PC
	Main board does not support USB port	Update main driver in PC
	PC system jam	Reboot PC
Unable to record	Memory is full	Download/delete files

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

TIPS BEFORE GETTING STARTED.

1. As every human head is slightly different, we recommend that you take a little time to setup the alignment of your Video Eye Gear before you get down to serious filming.

First take a few seconds of footage wearing the glasses in a comfortable position whilst making a mental note of what you're looking at. Then when you view the footage, you'll see if what you were looking at is in the centre of the frame.

If it shows that you've been filming low or high, you will need to compensate by either using our nose bridge spacers (in the box) or re-positioning the glasses slightly or tilting your head slightly. This is something you'll soon get used to.

2. These sleek sunglasses have been carefully and specially designed for both comfort and grip, and to accomplish this the arms are curved inwards, so please take extra care when putting the glasses on.
